Uniqueness. The terroir.

The region of Friuli Venezia Giulia, located in the North-East of Italy near Gorizia and the Isonzo river, is known for making excellent wine, mostly white. In the past, olive oil and fruit were also part of the production. After World War I and World War II though, vineyards took over the whole territory. Thanks to its terroir, the region yields high quality grapes and wines. Among these climatic and geographical characteristics we find the marl soil, the proximity to the sea, the protection of the Alps, and finally the sunny exposition of the southern side of the hills.

Style. The character.

Wine: produced entirely from Pinot Grigio. It was also called Rülander and Pineau Gris when it was introduced in the second half of the 1800's in the Gorizia area. This variety immediately adapted well to the soil, in particular the hilly slopes. It distinguishes itself from other white grapes for its copper hues.
